



Tattoo Appointment Deposit Policy & Preparation Guidelines

Thank you for choosing Hotrod Tattoo!

The entire staff at HRT is committed to providing you with the best possible experience, so please carefully read the following guidelines, they will aid in a smooth tattoo process.

Deposits are **NON-REFUNDABLE**.

There is no pressure to schedule your appointment, so please take all the time you need to make an informed decision. We highly encourage you to ask as many questions and schedule a consultation with the tattoo artist of your choice prior to scheduling your appointment.

1. We understand that schedules change, in the event you need to reschedule we do ask for **1 week notice** in order keep your deposit on file. Tattoo Artists work based on commission only, and it is difficult to find a replacement for your appointment. Please take this into consideration. If you need to reschedule your appointment with less than 1 week notice, we would be happy to chat with your artist to determine the status of your deposit (i.e. keep your deposit on file, or forfeit deposit).
2. If you are pregnant or nursing we can **NOT** tattoo you.
3. We understand your tattoo is very important, and we understand you might change your mind on your design- we need at least 48 hours notice to change your artwork. We can make simple changes the day of the tattoo, but we don't want to take away time from performing your tattoo. Please reschedule your tattoo if you are not sure of your design exactly, or are needing significant changes.
4. We will do our best to complete your tattoo in the time frame and price quoted. It is often that customers make adjustments in size and complexity, and this may require more time and additional costs. Our goal is to make your tattoo amazing, the more you invest financially and in time- "The more amazing your tattoo will be"
5. In order to make this a positive experience, we recommend that you get a good nights rest, eat a healthy meal, and drink plenty of water prior to your appointment.
6. We will **NOT** be able to tattoo you if you are under the influence of **DRUGS** or alcohol.
7. We can **NOT** tattoo you if you are sunburned or have over exposure to the sun in the area you are getting tattooed. Please refrain the week prior to your appointment as it can ultimately affect your tattoo.
